Nevada City Phased Reopening

LIMITED IN-PERSON SERVICES MARCH -MAY

- Social distancing is required in courthouse.
- Hearings for emergency matters in criminal, civil, probate, family law and juvenile are set M-T-Th.
- Jury trials are suspended.
- Traffic hearings are postponed.
- Collaborative Courts are postponed.
- Clerk's counters and Self-Help open for phone/email services, limited in-person filing and drop box filing accepted.
- Filing deadlines are extended.
- See Executive Orders #176 and #178.



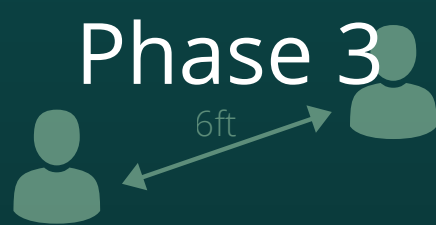
ALL SERVICES WITH SAFETY PRECAUTIONS JULY-TBD

- Increase jury trials with remote jury questionnaires.
- Use of telephone and video hearings is encouraged where possible.
- Small Claims and Traffic hearings resume.
- Clerk's counters and Self-Help services open.



INCREASED SERVICES AND HEARINGS JUNE-JULY

- Face coverings are required to enter courthouse.
- Criminal jury trials resume with remote questionnaires.
- No civil jury trials.
- Increasing Civil, Family and DCSS evidentiary hearings.
- Contact the court to schedule a remote appearance.
- Clerk's counters and Self-Help open for phone/email services, increased in-person services.
- Collaborative Courts resume.
- See Executive Orders #189, #190 and Local Rules.



RETURN TO REGULAR SERVICE TBD

A return to full in-person services is expected when public health and safety concerns have been mitigated.
