GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the July 8, 2020 Order ("Order") of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the July 7, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Nevada County ("Court"), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. With the concurrence of the Presiding Judge, the Court may order that sessions be held anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile detention facilities, on from July 7, 2020, to August 7, 2020, inclusive] (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(1));
- 2. For purposes of computing time for filing papers with the Court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a, from July 7, 2020, to August 7, 2020 inclusive, are deemed holidays because the emergency conditions described in the Order have substantially interfered with the public's ability to file papers in a court facility on those dates. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(4));
- 3. In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from July 7, 2020, to August 7, 2020, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days (Gov. Code. § 68115(a)(10));

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
