## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 200**

## The Court hereby orders:

All court appearances by incarcerated defendants shall begin with a remote appearance by Zoom. At the beginning of each remote appearance, the Court will ask the defendant if they consent to the remote appearance. If a defendant objects to a remote appearance, the Court will determine whether said defendant should be transported to the courthouse that day, for an inperson appearance, or whether the matter should be continued.
