Presiding Judges, Court Executive Officers, and Fiscal Contacts:

At today's July 12, 2024 business meeting, the Judicial Council approved 2024–25 Trial Court Trust Fund (TCTF) and General Fund allocations to the trial courts.

## **Allocation Workbook**

To assist courts with budgeting allocations, this year's allocation workbook includes two worksheets that display the trial court allocations and the Workload Formula allocations separately:

- The "TC Allocations" tab displays 2024–25 trial court base and non-base allocations and includes general ledger numbers for each allocation. Columns W through AA display the non-TCTF allocations.
- The "WF Allocation" tab displays the 2024–25 Final Workload Allocation (column X), the 2024–25 Workload Formula ("need") (column Y), and Workload Formula Percentage (column Z).

Also included is the 2024–25 Workload Formula which includes the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Resource Assessment Study, and Full-Time Equivalent need.

The final reduction for fund balances above the 3 percent cap, based on courts' final 2023–24 year-end fund balance figures, will occur following Judicial Council approval at its November 2024 business meeting.

## **Reporting Requirements**

As a reminder, California Rule of Court (CRC) 10.620(f) requires trial courts to provide notice no later than 15 court days after receipt of the annual allocation of the trial court budget from the Judicial Council after enactment of the Budget Act. Since this email serves as notification of courts' annual allocation for 2024–25, courts must provide public notice no later than Friday, August 2, 2024.

Examples of what can be done to provide notice and comply with the rule include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Posting this email and the 2024–25 Allocation Display of the attached workbook on the court's website; or
- 2. (b) Posting the links to the July 12, 2024 Judicial Council reports on the court's website.
