EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 210

Effective Feb 16, 2022, the Nevada County Public Health Officer revised the county masking order. Nevada County Public Health states, "it is still highly recommended that everyone, regardless of vaccination status, wear a high-quality mask while in public spaces." Effective February 28, 2023, Governor Newsom proclaimed an end to California's State of Emergency related to COVID-19. Effective April 3, 2023, the California Department of Public Health ("CDPH") revised its guidance regarding face coverings by replacing mandatory masking requirements in high-risk settings with recommendations based on the Centers for Disease Control's COVID-19 community levels. Effective April 10, 2023, President Biden signed H.J. Resolution 7, which terminated the national state of emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Accordingly, based on the foregoing, Executive Order No. 205 is hereby rescinded.
