- 6. The limitation in item 6(d) of the temporary order and 10(d) of the permanent order does not preclude the guardian from receiving any child support payments, Social Security or other public benefits as determined by the appropriate agencies, for or related to the minor.
- 7. Any time the mailing address for the minor(s) changes, the guardian(s) shall complete and file the Judicial Council Form Change of Residence Notice (GC-080) with the Court. The guardian(s) shall not change the residence of the minor(s) to a place outside of California without first obtaining an order from this court approving the move.
- 8. Any time the mailing address for the guardian(s) changes, the guardian(s) shall complete and file the Judicial Council Form Notice of Change of Address (MC-040) with the court.
