

Efiling Exceptions List

Pursuant to Local Rule of Court 1.06, the following documents are exceptions to electronic filing.

The following original documents must be submitted with a courtesy electronic copy.

- Documents required to be filed with the court as an original:
 - o Affidavits re real property of small value
 - o Bonds
 - o Undertakings
 - o Letters of authorization (probate, guardianship, conservatorship issued by another court)
 - o Wills and codicils (for filing or safekeeping)
 - o Certified judgments (except UIFSA judgments and orders)
 - o Abstract of Judgment
 - o Writs
 - o Out of State or Out of County Abstracts or Commissions

The following documents shall not be submitted via electronic filing unless specifically ordered.

- Documents submitted with the court as an original for safekeeping, including:
 - o Subpoenaed documents
 - o Financial documents submitted by a private professional conservator,
 - o Orders to deposit money and receipt of depository (pursuant to Probate Code section 2620)
 - o Labor Commissioner deposit of cash or check
 - o Evidentiary documents typically submitted in court during the course of a hearing
 - o Psychological or medical documentation related to a minor when not included in a summary report (pursuant to Welfare & Institutions Code Section 16010)
