

## February 27, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

**1. P00-13241 In the Matter of Kyle Weston Hawkins**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for February 25, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

**2. P05-14145 In the Matter of Jennifer Lee Arvisais**

No appearances are required. The petition for attorney's fees are granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

**3. P06-14335 In the Matter of Rebecca Mary Elizabeth Hengesbach**

Appearances are required. The Court is favorably inclined to grant the petition to add Co-Conservator Julie Dunigan. Proof of service of the citation has not presently been filed. Petitioner shall address the same.

Additionally, the conservatorship still appears to be warranted and the Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement, quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for December 17, 2027, at 9:00 a.m. in Dept. 6. The court investigation fee is waived.

**4. P07-14637 In the Matter of Timothy S. L. Hengesbach**

No appearances are required. The petition to add a Co-Conservator is granted as prayed. Julie Dunigan is appointed as a Conservator of the person. Counsel for Ms. Dunigan shall submit a proposed order.

The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for February 25, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

**8. P20-16753 In the Matter of Todd A. Kalbach**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for February 25, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

**9. PR0000334 In the Matter of Thomas Wayne Kirk**

No appearances are required. The petition for final distribution is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

**10. PR0000631 In the Matter of William Edward Corwin**

No appearances are required. The petition for final distribution is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

**11. PR0000643 In the Matter of Thomas C. Norton**

No appearances are required. The Court dismisses the order to show cause in the interests of justice. No accounting is necessary in connection with the conservatorship given that the sole asset was community property managed by the spouse/Conservator. See Probate Code § 3051(b).

**12. PR0000645 In Re Walter Mari Ingram**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person and estate shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for February 25, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this annual review is waived.

**13. PR0000655 In the Matter of Willah Brave Barlow Dunwody**

No appearances are required. The Court continues this matter to April 17, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6 for consideration of Petitioner's motion to modify the order appointing guardian and allow investment of certain guardianship funds.

**14. PR0000946 In the Matter of Mary Kathryn Perry**

No appearances are required. The petition for termination of B and C trusts is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

**15. PR0000947 In the Matter of Carolyn Wilson Gregory**

No appearances are required. The petition for order confirming trust asset is granted as prayed. Petitioner shall provide a proposed order.

**16. PR0000948 In the Matter of Scott Anthony Lytle**

No appearances are required. The petition to determine succession to primary residence is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.
