

March 13, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

1. P05-14266 In the Matter of Jacob Davis

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person and estate shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for March 10, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

2. P06-14335 In the Matter of Rebecca Mary Elizabeth Hengesbach

No appearances are required. The petition to add a Co-Conservator is granted as prayed. Julie Dunigan is appointed as a Conservator of the person. Counsel for Ms. Dunigan shall submit a proposed order.

Additionally, the conservatorship still appears to be warranted and the Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement, quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for December 17, 2027, at 9:00 a.m. in Dept. 6. The court investigation fee is waived.

3. P06-14446 In the Matter of Kristopher P. Barletta

No appearances are required. The Court has not received the court investigation report. The Court continues this matter for receipt of the report to May 22, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 6. The Clerk shall provide a copy of the minutes to the Court Investigator. The Clerk shall also telephonically notify the Court Investigator.

4. P21-16816 In the Matter of Triston Pestun

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for March 10, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

5. P89-10877 In the Matter of Thomas Michael Odom

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person and estate shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for March 10, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

The Court notes that an annual accounting is now due. The Court sets a hearing on May 22, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6 regarding the same. Conservator shall file an annual accounting in advance of the continued court date.

6. PR0000595 In the Matter of William Aaron Burnes

No appearances are required. The Court continues this matter to May 22, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6, and sets an order to show cause hearing for the same date and time. Petitioner shall show cause why she should not be sanctioned for failing to update the Court on the status of this estate as ordered by this Court on September 12, 2025. The clerk shall provide notice of the order to show cause.

7. PR0000686 In the Matter of William Arthur Riske, Jr.

No appearances are required. The petition for final distribution is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

8. PR0000856 In the Matter of Michael Dennis Grayson

No appearances are required. The petition to administer filed by Petitioner Joshua Grayson is granted and letters shall issue. A proposed order has been submitted. The petition filed by Denise Molling-Grayson is denied; the December 3, 2025, objections thereto by Joshua Grayson are sustained in their entirety. In addition, the Court notes that Petitioner Molling-Grayson has failed to lodge the original will at issue with the Court. *See* Local Rule 8.06.

9. PR0000940 In the Matter of Judith Rodrigues

No appearances are required. The Court continues this matter to May 22, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The petition does not include proof of service of a citation (See GC-320). Additionally, does not include a screening form for the proposed Conservator (See GC-314). Petitioner shall file the same prior to the continued court date.

The Court appoints Richard Keene as counsel for the proposed Conservatee. The Clerk shall notify Mr. Keene of the appointment and provide a copy of the minutes.
