

March 6, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

1. P94-11865 In the Matter of Mark Robert Pinter

On the Court's motion, this hearing is continued to March 9, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for March 10, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

2. PR0000668 In the Matter of Sage Marie Davis Da Rosa

On the Court's motion, this hearing is continued to March 9, 2026, at 9:30 a.m.

No appearances are required. The accounting is noticed for hearing May 1, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. Accordingly, the Court continues this matter to that date and time.
