

April 6, 2026, Case Management Conference Tentative Rulings

- 1. CL0002141 Discover Bank vs. Sequoia U. Nicholas**
Appearances are required. All parties shall show cause why they should not be sanctioned for failing to appear as ordered on February 2, 2026.
- 2. CL0002994 U.S. Bank National Association vs. Dylan Cauraugh**
No appearances are required. The Court dismisses this matter without prejudice and retains jurisdiction pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6.
- 3. CL0003187 Mercury Insurance Company vs. William Tanner**
Appearances are required for status regarding dismissal. If the parties wish the Court to retain jurisdiction, they should file a written stipulation under Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6 or state their agreement regarding the same on the record.
- 4. CL0003643 JPMorgan Chase Bank N.A. vs. Holly Korbonski**
No appearances are required. A status regarding default judgment is set for June 15, 2026, at 1:00 p.m., in Department 6. Plaintiff shall submit a complete request for default judgment at least two weeks prior thereto.

- 6. CU0001721 Makyla C. Savitri v. Jeff Thompson**
Appearances are required for status regarding dismissal. If the parties wish the Court to retain jurisdiction, they should file a written stipulation under Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6 or state their agreement regarding the same on the record.
- 7. CU0001845 Mark Gold, et al. vs. Robert A. Tonnies, et al.**
No appearances are required. On its own motion, the Court continues the case management conference to May 4, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. This case appears to be at issue. However, Defendants' prior counsel was recently relieved and defendants have failed to timely file a case management conference statement. All parties shall file a timely case management conference statement prior to the continued court date including recommendations as to available dates for purposes of trial.
- 8. CU0001978 Bridgett Higginbotham vs. Pacific Specialty Insurance, et al.**
No appearances are required. On the Court's motion, the case management conference is continued to July 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6, to permit adjudication of pending

motions.

- 9. CU0001994 Peter Baga vs. Clifford Christopher Webb, et al.**
Appearances are required. Plaintiff shall show cause why he should not be sanctioned for failing to appear as ordered on December 15, 2025. Moreover, Plaintiff shall explain why the summons and complaint apparently have not been served on defendant Webb.

Appearances are required. The parties and directed to show cause why this matter should not be dismissed with retention of jurisdiction under Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6(e) in light of the July 9, 2025, notice of conditional settlement.
- 12. CU0002199 Russell Constable v. Lyla Tracy**
Appearances are required. Plaintiff shall show cause why he should not be sanctioned or this case dismissed for failure to file a proof of service, and application for service by publication, or a request for dismissal of defendant as ordered by this Court on September 29, 2025. Additionally, Plaintiff shall show cause why he should not be sanctioned for failing to timely file a case management conference statement.

No appearances are required. This case is at issue. Jury fees are paid.
