

## May 8, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

**1. P00-13109 In the Matter of Tracy Ann Gamache**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person and estate shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for May 5, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

**2. P10-14991 In the Matter of Kevin M. Hepner**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for May 5, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

**3. P11-15182 In the Matter of Jacquelyn Munoz**

No appearances are required. The Court continues the review hearing to August 7, 2026 at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6 and sets an order to show cause hearing for the same date and time. Conservator shall show cause why she should not be sanctioned for failing to file with this Court an order from Idaho accepting the conservatorship as directed on February 27, 2026. The clerk shall serve notice of the order to show cause.

**4. P15-15706 In the Matter of Jackson Bandimere**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for May 5, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

**5. P18-16274 In the Matter of Codi R. Heafey**

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservator is acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for May 5, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

Additionally, the Court sets an order to show cause hearing for August 7, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. It appears the Conservator and Conservatee reside in Sacramento County. Conservator shall show cause why venue is not more appropriate in Sacramento County and why this matter should not be transferred to Sacramento County. The clerk

shall serve notice of the order to show cause.

**6. PR0000181 In Re Mark Kenneth Barbieri**

No appearances are required. The Court has received notice of death of the Conservatee. The Court notes no accountings are due as they were previously waived on May 10, 2024.

**7. PR0000788 In the Matter of Ralph Thomas Harper**

No appearances are required. The petition for final distribution is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been provided.

**8. PR0000979 In the Matter of John P. Stabile**

No appearances are required. The Court continues this matter to July 24, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The Court has not yet received the Court Investigator's report. On April 23, 2026, the Court Investigator requested 30 days to complete the report.

**9. PR0000994 In the Matter of Josette Garrett**

No appearances are required. On its own motion the court continues this matter to August 7, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. Pursuant to Probate Code section 1202, the Court orders Petitioner to provide personal service of the petition on Trustee David True and Respondent Michael Myrick. Petitioner shall provide proof of service of the petition prior to the continued court date. Petitioner shall also provide notice of the continued court date.

**10. PR0001022 In the Matter of Kenneth Givens**

No appearances are required. The Court continues this request to May 29, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The Court has not received the Court Investigator's report. *See* Prob. Code 2250.6 The Court continues this matter for receipt of the report. The Clerk shall provide a copy of the minutes to the Court Investigator. The Clerk shall also telephonically notify the Court Investigator.
