

June 15, 2026, Case Management Conference Tentative Rulings

- 1. CL0002073 Synchrony Bank vs. Nori J. Bates**
Appearances are required. All parties shall show cause why this matter should not be dismissed with retention of jurisdiction pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6(e).
- 2. CL0002610 Charly Hodge vs. Doe Defendant**
No appearances are required. On its own motion, the Court continues the case management conference to December 14, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. Plaintiff shall file a proof of service, an application for service by publication (as appropriate), or a request for dismissal of Defendant no later than two weeks prior to the continued case management conference date.
