

August 21, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

1. CU0001483 Susan Gabrielle, vs. Phillip G. Conlon, Jr.

No appearances are required. In light of the parties joint statement, the Court continues the review hearing to November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The parties shall submit a joint review hearing statement two weeks prior to the continued review date.

2. P14-15697 In the Matter of Justin Rae Kohnke

No appearances are required. The Court has not received the biennial review report and continues this matter to November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The Clerk shall provide a copy of the minutes to the Court Investigator. The Clerk shall also telephonically notify the Court Investigator.

3. PR0000453 In the Matter of Suzanne M. Perry-Miller

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person and estate shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next biennial review is set for August 25, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. It is alleged the estate has sufficient funds to pay for the investigative fee. Quest investigations shall submit their fee request. Absent objection, the Court shall order the estate to pay the investigation fee.

The petition for accounting and allowance of related fees is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

The petition for reimbursement to conservator is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

The August 13, 2026, inventory and appraisal has been received. That document does not include real property apparently owned by the estate in the Los Angeles area. A status hearing regarding the filing of an amended inventory and appraisal is set for November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The amended document shall be filed as soon as possible and no later than one month in advance of the scheduled hearing.

4. PR0000595 In the Matter of William Aaron Burnes

Appearances are required. Linda Burnes shall show cause as to which of the two orders to administer should be allowed to proceed and which should be vacated in connection with this case and case PR0000858.

5. PR0000858 In the Matter of William Aaron Burnes

Appearances are required. Christine Burnes shall show cause as to which of the two orders to administer should be allowed to proceed and which should be vacated in connection with this case and case PR0000595.

6. PR0000792 Conservatorship of Andrea Gunderson

No appearances are required. The Court on its own motion continues this matter to November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The Court is favorably inclined to grant the petition to appoint successor conservator but seeks input from counsel for the Conservatee, Ms. Lenore. Prior to the continued court date, counsel for Conservatee shall provide a report on the position of the Conservatee. The Clerk shall provide a copy of the minutes to all parties including counsel Lenore.

7. PR0000955 In the Matter of Joan M. O'Donnell

No appearances are required. The Court continues this matter to November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6 and sets an order to show cause hearing for the same date and time. Conservator Ann Sagerdahl shall show cause why she should not be sanctioned for her failure to file an inventory and appraisal as ordered by the Court on June 5, 2026. The clerk shall serve notice of the order to show cause.

8. PR0000965 In the Matter of Katherine Kimmel

No appearances are required. The Court on its own motion continues this matter to November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. In light of the Court Investigator's report, the Court requests Petitioner and proposed Conservatee's counsel provide a brief, of no more than 3 pages, indicating whether this Court has jurisdiction to accept transfer of this Conservatorship given that the proposed Conservatee's whereabouts are unknown.

9. PR0001014 In the Matter of Kayla Rudolph

No appearances are required. The Court continues this matter to November 20, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. Based on the report of the Court Investigator, the Court is inclined to designate this request as a request for limited conservatorship pursuant to Probate Code section 1800.3(d) based on the proposed Conservatee's developmental disability. Therefore, the Court orders Petitioner to provide notice to Alta Regional Center pursuant to Probate Code section 1461.4 and further directs Alta Regional Center prepare a report and recommendation for the Court's consideration. The clerk shall also provide a copy of the minutes to Alta Regional Center.
