

September 11, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

1. P08-14720 In the Matter of Jennifer M. Andes

No appearances are required. The conservatorship of the person shall continue. The conservatorship still appears to be warranted. The Conservators are acting in the best interests of the Conservatee regarding the Conservatee's placement and quality of care, including physical and mental treatment. The next review is set for September 15, 2028, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The court investigation fee for this biennial review is waived.

2. P12-15410 In the Matter of Michol Noell Stephenson

No appearances are required. The Court has not received the biennial review report and continues this matter to December 11, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 6. The Clerk shall provide a copy of the minutes to the Court Investigator. The Clerk shall also telephonically notify the Court Investigator.

3. PR0000188 In the Matter of Todd Alan Goodin
