

July 24, 2026, Probate Tentative Rulings

1. P06-14356 In the Matter of Alan O. Nicol 1992 Revocable Trust

No appearances are required. The petition for accounting and for fees is granted as prayed. A proposed order has been submitted.

2. P17-16158 In the Matter of Richard Joseph Nathaniel Rouse, et al.

No appearances are required. On the Court's motion, this matter is continued to October 16, 2026, at 09:00 a.m. in Department 6, and an order to show cause is set for the same date and time. Petitioner shall show cause why he should not be sanctioned or this petition dismissed for failing to serve the instant petition and supplemental briefing on Goodwill and the Washoe Tribe as ordered by this Court on April 24, 2026. If Petitioner does not appear at the next hearing, the Petition will be dismissed. The clerk shall give notice of the order to show cause.

3. PR0000237 In Re Klaus Mathes

Code § 8121.) Petitioner shall provide the outstanding item prior to the continued court date and provide notice of the continued court hearing date.
